We recognize that you entrust important personal information to us, and we wish to assure you that we take our responsibilities seriously in protecting and safeguarding this information. Browsing

Data collected when corresponding with us

This privacy statement applies solely to information collected by our Website. Data Security

We Unite takes every precaution to protect your information. When you submit personal information via We Unite Website, your information is protected both online and offline. For example, when our registration form asks you to enter personal information, the information is protected during transmission by an industry standard high level of encryption - 256-bit SSL.
